SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER / DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

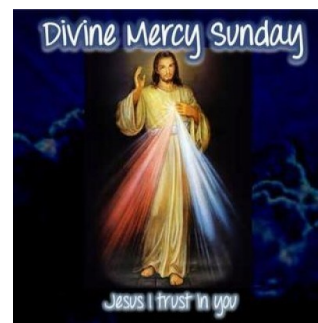
The Sunday after Easter is Divine Mercy Sunday.

With the canonization of Saint Faustina, Pope John Paul II, now Saint John Paul II, declared that “the Second Sunday of Easter, henceforth throughout the Church will also be called Divine Mercy Sunday.”

From the diary of Saint Faustina, Our Lord said,
“**Who approaches the Fountain of Life (Holy Communion) on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.**”
(Diary, #300).

To receive the special graces of Divine Mercy Sunday:

- Place complete trust in God’s mercy;
- Repent all of your sins and punishment and receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation within a reasonable time before the Feast
- Celebrate God’s mercy by attending Mass and receiving Holy Communion on the Sunday after Easter, Divine Mercy Sunday
- Venerate the image of Jesus, The Divine Mercy;
- Be merciful to others, by our actions, words, or prayers on their behalf.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick offers prayer for healing, hope, and strength and is intended for a Catholic at the beginning of a serious illness, before surgery or weakened due to age or chronic infirmity.

Viaticum, "Food for the Journey", is Holy Communion with special prayers for the dying and serves as the "last rites" for Catholics who are terminally ill and in the last stages of life.

Our parish clergy are always willing to visit hospitals to pray with and support those who are ill. Sacraments in the hospital are provided by the designated Catholic Chaplain. Extraordinary

Ministers of Holy Communion generously make themselves available to bring Holy Communion to the home-bound of our parish. Please contact the Parish Office to arrange for any of these services.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

In accordance with Archdiocesan Policy, couples contemplating marriage are to begin their preparation for the Sacrament of Marriage at least six months before their anticipated wedding date. Call the Parish Office or visit our website for more information.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents and godparents of children to be baptized are required to participate in Baptismal preparation sessions. This can be done even before the birth of the child.

Ordinarily, Baptisms are scheduled in our parish once each month, following a weekend Mass for all families celebrating Baptisms at that time.
