Dear brothers and sisters in the Lord,

Today we enter into the most sacred week of the liturgical year - Holy Week. We begin to walk with Christ the last week of His life, a week that ended in his terrible Passion and glorious Resurrection.

As we have joined the crowds in waving palms and acclaiming Jesus in His triumphal entry into Jerusalem, I invite you to join us for the sacred liturgies that will be celebrated this week at Our Lady of the Rosary.

In the weekday Masses of Monday through Wednesday, we will prepare with Christ for the arduous road ahead. In the Mass of the Lord's Supper, we will remember the command of charity that the Lord gives all Christians as he washed the feet of his disciples; and we will commemorate the institution of the holy priesthood given to His Apostles and the Holy Eucharist of the Body and Blood of Christ given for the salvation of all people.

On Good Friday, we will walk the Way of the Cross with Jesus and stand with Blessed Mary at the foot of the Cross as Jesus lays down His life for us; and we will venerate the Wood of the Cross on which hung the salvation of the world. At Easter Vigil, our sorrow will turn to rejoicing as we encounter the empty tomb and the joy of the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ, who is the Light of the World. At Easter Vigil this year, we will welcome 8 new Catholics into our parish family, who will receive some or all of the sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.

On this sheet you can find the schedule of all our Holy Week services. Please join us for the sacred liturgies of the Paschal Triduum and allow the great mysteries of our salvation to lead you to an encounter with the living God who saves us and raises us up.
